# BACKGROUND

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2001: The Texas Legislature created the Texas Task Force on Indigent Defense

2011: Texas Indigent Defense Commission (TIDC)

HB 1318 - by the 83rd Legislature amended Gov Code section 79.036 required counties to breakdown data by attorney.

SB 560 - by the 86th Legislature added expenditures and appointment data regarding CPS cases.

SB 380 – by the 88<sup>th</sup> Legislature added appointment data regarding Interpreters.

# TYPE OF EXPENDITURES

**Attorney Fees** – money paid by the county or managed assigned counsel program to a licensed attorney in accordance with the statute and local fee schedule for legal services rendered to an indigent defendant, juvenile respondent, or party in a suit affecting the parent-child relationship or suit requesting a parent be ordered to complete services filed by the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services

**Social Work** – work carried out by trained personnel with the aim of alleviating the conditions of those in need of help or welfare

**Expert Witness** – money paid by the county or managed assigned counsel program to a person/entity qualified by the court or by special certifications in a field of study or expertise to provide assistance to a licensed attorney in preparing or presenting a defense for a party in a suit affecting the parent-child relationship or suit requesting a parent be ordered to complete services filed by the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services

**Investigator** – money paid by the county or managed assigned counsel program to a person licensed as an investigator or otherwise legally able to conduct investigations for a licensed attorney in preparing a defense for a party in a suit affecting the parent-child relationship or suit requesting a parent be ordered to complete services filed by the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services

**Other Litigation** – money paid by the county or managed assigned counsel program to a person or entity for materials, supplies, or services determined by the attorney or court necessary for the licensed attorney to prepare an adequate defense for a party in a suit affecting the parent-child relationship or suit requesting a parent be ordered to complete services filed by the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services

## **Custodial Parents**

- **For individual appointments for a mother or father:**
  - Child is living with this parent at the time of the legal filing.
  - If child is living with the father, paternity has also been established.

## **Non-Custodial Parents**

- Child is not living with this parent at the time of the legal filing and/or paternity has not been established
- An alleged father who is living with the child at the time of legal filing but is not living with the mother is considered and non-custodial parent regardless of where the child is living.

## **Non-Parent Conservator**

- Person who is not a parent and has previously been named on a court order as the conservator of the child.

## **Children**

### **Adult Appeal**

- Must be counted as a separate case from the original trial level case.

### **Children Appeal**

- Must be counted as a separate case from the original trial level case.

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- Interpreters on staff – report salary and fringe
- Interpreters paid by the day that are assigned a court
- Interpreters that come to the jail if they are on staff or contracted by the county
- Interpreters provided free of charge, irrespective of ability to pay in criminal or juvenile cases
- Interpreters who provided services in criminal, civil, or juvenile cases prior to a court appearance in front of a judge
- Interpretation services provided even if the case never makes it to trial

# **INTERPRETER REPORTING : FY 2024**

## **SB 380/HB 3474 (88<sup>TH</sup> LEGISLATURE)**

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Data should only include matters held at the district and county court levels.

Data to be reported on the TIDC IDER.

The first year of data will cover October 1, 2023 – September 30, 2024, and is due by November 1, 2024.
